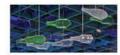

CREATING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE TOGETHER

LIGHTING

Lights throughout the store have been replaced with ecofriendly LED's. Cabinets in the back of the store were removed to let in more natural daylight.



SUSTAINABLE ART

Artist Kathleen Plate handmade the store's featured eco-art ceiling display using glass bottles recovered from dumpsters headed to the landfill.

STORE SIGNAGE

We removed all plexiglass from the store. All the signage was created using eco-friendly printing options, recycled FSC certified substraights and lit LED panels for large scale graphics.



SUSTAINABLE PRODUCTS

The National Aquarium store hosts an entire collection of sustainable, local, recycled, and eco-friendly products for the conscious consumer.



From toys to t-shirts made out of recycled milk containers, to bags created from retired boat sails.

Green informational signage for products throughout the store.



REDUCE, REUSE

Integrated the old ceiling design into the new design so it could be reused instead of being replaced. Old fixtures have been upcycled to other retail locations.

WALL SOLUTIONS

We used zero VOC paint by Benjamin Moore, sustainable and durable 2Stone Concrete Veneer for the cash-wrap, and Dimensional Impact MDF Retail Panels from FSC certified sources.

NET EFFECT CARPET

Project Net-Works" provides a source of income for small fishing villages in the Philippines while cleaning up their beaches and waters of discarded fishing

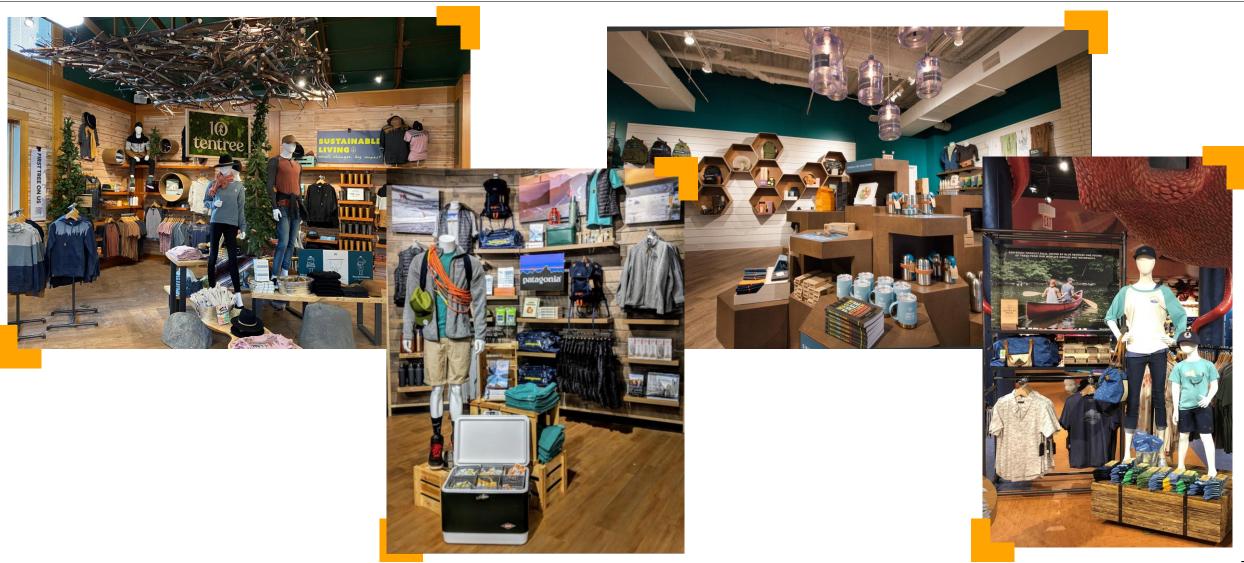


nets that threaten precious reef off their shore. Nets are collected and repurposed to provide recycled content nylon for interface carpet tile.

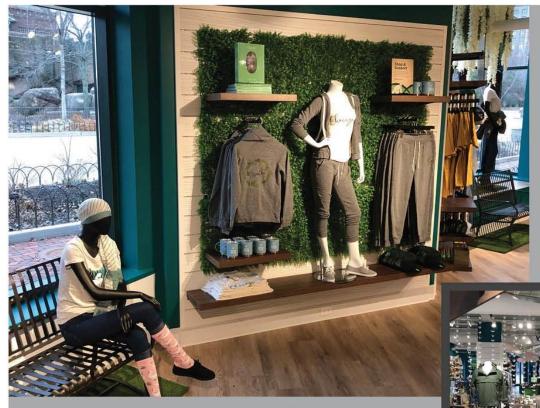
WOODLAND PARK ZOO SEATTLE, WASHINGTON

Through engaging exhibits and programming, the Woodland Park Zoo helps raise awareness and educate guests on the importance of conservation and ways individuals and communities can take action to preserve our natural habitat. Event Network has extended this message throughout the Gift Shops-removing plastic materials from the store environments and incorporating eco-friendly materials, such as brick MDF slat wall made from FSC certified sources. Product, displays and signage also reiterate this important message.

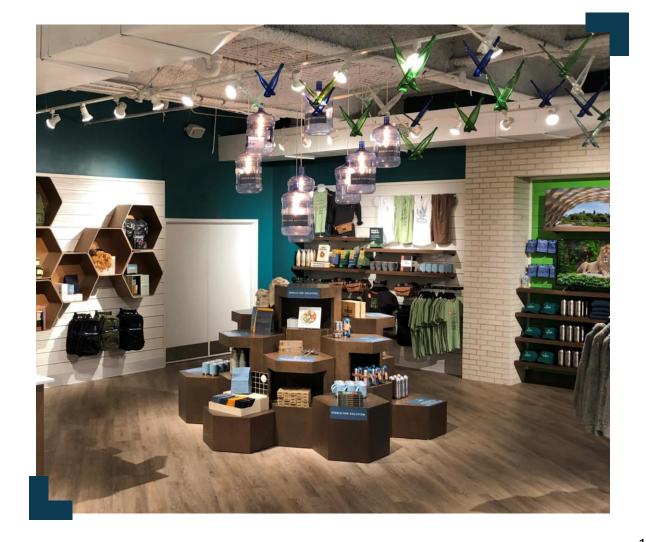

BEFOREMultiple single-use plastic bags and
Styrofoam in a large outer box



AFTER

Re-think and re-engineer packaging and product assembly. Remove all inner plastic bags, Styrofoam and inner-boxes. Reduce box size and weight for less shipping costs.



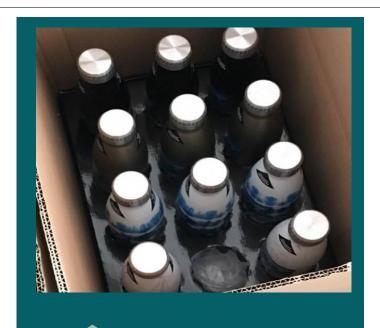
